The Merrimack Valley Workforce Investment Board (MVWIB), working in conjunction with the Division of Grants Administration, will be issuing a Request for Bids (RFB) utilizing U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Environmental Workforce Development and Job Training Funds.

The RFB will solicit bids to provide a deconstruction training program for unemployed and underemployed adults. Organizations eligible to apply include: units of government, community based organizations, business organizations, local school districts, educational collaboratives and other educational and training institutions.

The RFB will be released on **Tuesday, January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012**. Proposal packages will be available that day at the MVWIB office located at 439 S.
